



**Sailor's Delight Workshop Supply List**  
**Block Size: 12" Peggy Martin, Instructor**

Sailor's Delight is a simplified Mariner's Compass, sewn with octagon wedges and no circles! Learn to sew this fun and easy block with Quick-Strip Paper Piecing, an assembly-line method of paper piecing on strips. A variety of settings and projects will be presented in class, using one block or multiple blocks, including wallhangings, table runner and placemats. Block patterns provided in class.



Woven variation

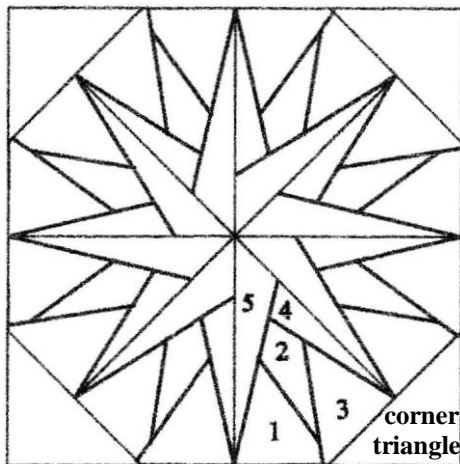
**NOTE: Sewing machines, irons and ironing boards will be provided in class; do not bring your own**

**Supplies:**

- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Neutral-colored sewing thread (often supplied by sewing machine dealers, but might be needed)
- Fabric scissors and paper scissors, pins, seam ripper and other basic sewing supplies
- Paper grocery bag for your trash and trimmings
- Spray starch (see below; use on fabric before cutting strips before class, not necessary to bring to class)

**Before class:** Spray starch fabrics and cut strips from the chart below to be ready for sewing.

If you are unsure of your fabric choices, bring a variety of fabrics to class and select which ones you would like to use and cut strips during class.



**Sailor's Delight 12" block**

*Numbers below correspond to the numbered block pictured.*

*Cut strips ahead of time to be ready for sewing.*

**IMPORTANT!! Be sure to bring along the remaining yardage from listed amounts below to have extra fabric in case you need it; yardage varies in width, and mistakes can happen!**

**Note: All strips are cut from selvage to selvage, about 40" long**

**Fabrics for one 12" block:**

- #1 and #3: Background: 1/2 yard
- #2 Small points: 1/4 yard
- #4 Medium points: 1/4 yard
- #5 Long points: 1/4 yard of 1 or 2 fabrics

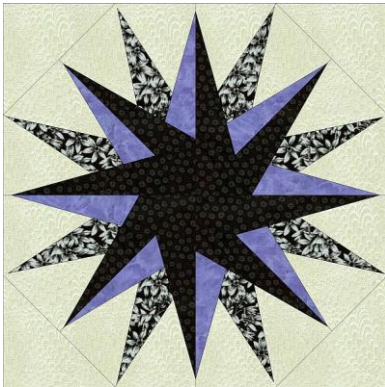
**Cut:**

- 2 or 3 strips 3"; Corner triangles, cut 2 squares 4 1/2"\*
- 1 or 2 strips 2"
- 1 or 2 strips 2" (or cut 2 1/4" for Woven Variation to also use for #5)
- cut 2 strips 2 1/4"

\* Corner square may be cut from a different fabric if desired.

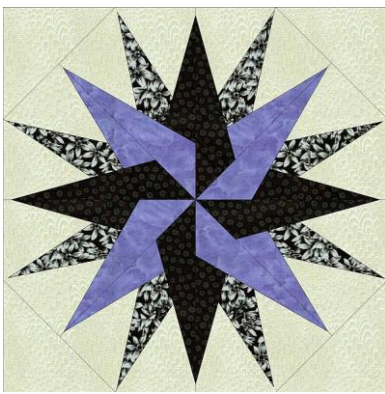
**Option 1: 3-color Mariner's Compass**

Background plus 3 point fabrics

- All 8 wedges the same
- #1 and #3 background
- #2 small point (black & white print)
- #4 medium point (medium fabric)
- #5 long point (dark fabric)



Wedge  
Make 8



**Option 2: Woven**

Background plus 3 point fabrics  
 #1 and #3 background, both A & B  
 #2 small point (B&W print), both A&B

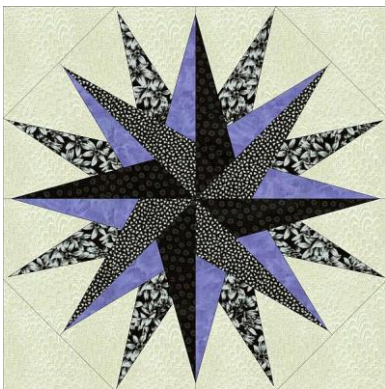
Make 4 of wedge A: Med. #4, Dark #5  
 Make 4 of wedge B: Dark #4, Med. #5  
 (Cut strips for both #4 and #5 at 2 1/4")  
 Alternate wedges when sewing block together  
 to create woven effect

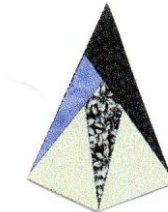

**Option 3: 4-color Mariner's Compass**

Background plus 4 point fabrics  
 #1 and #3 background both A & B  
 #2 small point (b & w print) both A&B  
 #4 same fabric in both A&B

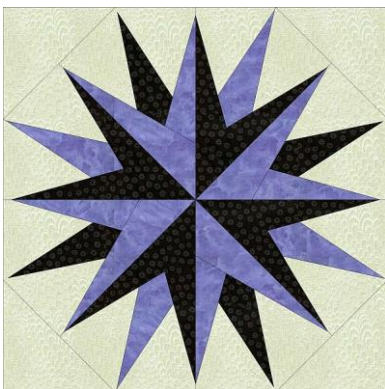
Long point #5, alternate 2 different fabrics:  
 Wedge A: Make 4 wedges dark #5  
 Wedge B: Make 4 wedges medium #5  
 Alternate wedges when sewing blocks together

**Option 4: 2-color positive/negative**

Background plus 2 point fabrics  
 #1 and #3 background  
 Alternate 2 fabrics in all point positions  
 Wedge A: make 4 med. #2, dark #4 and #5  
 Wedge B: make 4 dark #2, med. #4 and #5
