

Winged Star Workshop Supply List Peggy Martin, Instructor

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Winged Star block size: 15" Center Le Moyne Star 6" Quilt size including borders: 24"

Create blocks and borders with a feathered-star look using this fast, fun technique. Triangles are sewn together, cut apart and re-pieced to form a variety of blocks and border designs. The star center is a 6" square. In this example, a 6" LeMoyne Star has been used in the center (fabrics for it included in supply list and directions given in class), but you could substitute any other 6" block of your choosing, or use a beautiful fabric or appliqué for the center of your project.

Supplies:

Note: Sewing machines, irons and ironing boards are provided in class (do <u>not</u> bring your own)

Neutral-colored thread (usually provided by the sewing machine dealers, but a good idea to bring along, just in case

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (at least 6" x 12")

Also recommended: 6" or 6 1/2" square rotary ruler with diagonal line for squaring up pieced units -My favorites: Quilters Rule Mini Square 6 ¹/₂" ruler, or Omnigrid Omnigrip 6 ¹/₂" square ruler

Neutral sewing thread to blend with your fabrics

Scissors, pins, seam ripper

Optional: a piece of template plastic to fussy-cut block center

Paper grocery bag for your trash and trimmings

Fabrics:

Be sure to have a good contrast between fabrics.

Background: 1 yard light

Star points, borders and binding: 1 yard dark

Inner star points and outer border triangles: 1/4 yard medium

Options for centers:

1. Piece a 6" block for centers, such as the 6" LeMoyne star shown above (fabric included in supply list) OR

2. Bring a large-scale print to fussy-cut at 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

OR

3. Enough yardage to fussy-cut four identical 3 ¹/₂" squares or 4 identical triangles for 6" center
